NATO MILITARY MEDICAL VISION AND OBJECTIVES 2015-2024

Introduction:

NATO Centre of Excellence for Military Medicine (MILMED COE) is the only multinational centre, outside of the NATO command structure, dealing with military medicine at the international level, on a full time basis.

MILMED COE is designated by the Chiefs of Military Medical Services in NATO (COMEDS) to be the information knowledge management centre in the field of military medicine, coordinating the flow of information between key stakeholders within, and outside, the Alliance.

In this critical role, MILMED COE provides the Alliance with a coordinating body able to have an oversight of the key priority areas in NATO's medical transformation. Additionally, the work of the COE is in line with COMEDS Strategic Goals 2015-2020 which are represented in the strategic and overarching goals of the MILMED COE.

MILMED COE is accredited by TÜV ISO 9001:2015 (Cert No: 12 100 52039 TMS, Eff: 2016-12-15, Exp: 2019-11-17) and get Unconditional Accreditation by ACT as a NATO Education and Training Facility (Cert No:5000/TSC TPX 0180/TT-161134/Ser: NU; Eff:22-09-2016; Exp:21-09-2022) which documents the outstanding level of excellence that MILMED COE brings to the work it performs
